9. Type & Production. Official lactation. Doe must have completed an official lactation not exceeding 365 days anywhere in Aust. Within the last two years of the date of the Show. Test sheet to be shown to Stewards at the Show.
10. Doe, any breed, with Best Udder on 1st lactation (to be judged in milk and milked out).
11. Doe, any breed, with Best Udder on 2nd or subsequent lactation (to be judged in milk and milked out).

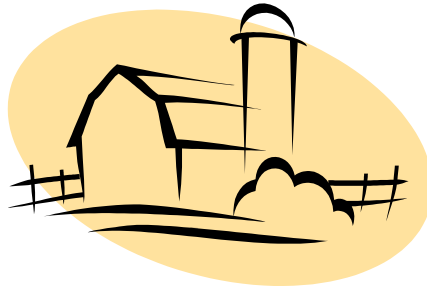
