# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO SHOWGROUND

Nabiac Showgrounds is a designated **glass free** area, so no glass drink containers are to be brought onto the Nabiac Showgrounds.

The Wallamba District A & H Assoc. Inc. reserves the right to search for any prohibited item including, but not limited to, weapons, controlled, dangerous or illegal substances, alcohol (bottles or cans) which are expressly forbidden and subject to confiscation.

No alcohol is to be carried or consumed in the sideshow area. Alcohol must only be consumed in the designated licence area. Drunken, unruly offensive behaviour or fighting will result in immediate removal from the showground.

The speed limit for all vehicles within the showground area is 5 kilometres per hour which is walking speed.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

Any exhibitor intending to bring electrical equipment to the showground will be required to ensure all electric leads, tools, and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is a requirement of The Occupational Health and Safety act 1983.

## RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY APPLYING TO ALL BREEDS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- ALL CATTLE MUST BE TESTED FOR "PESTI VIRUS" & CERTIFICATE MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM
- ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SIGN AN INDEMNITY & WAIVER FORM
- All exhibits must be owned, and have been owned, for at least one month prior to the Show, as well as being registered (or eligible) with their respective Breed Society.
- The age of stud beef cattle shall be the actual age up to and including 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2025.
- The Judge reserves the right to make the final decision.
- All exhibits must be available for inspection to persons nominated by the Society at any time for any reason.
- The Society will not be held responsible for loss, mis-delivery or damage of exhibits.
- Exhibitors must be ready to parade when Class is called.
- All bulls over 12 months MUST be fitted with a nose ring.
- All other cattle must be haltered and led with an approved nose grip fitted.
- A heifer is a female that is not over 3 years and has not had a calf.
- A calf under 8 months must parade with its mother in the cow class.
- Cattle shown in Breed Classes are NOT eligible to enter Led Steer/Heifer Classes.
- Young Paraders to lead heifers or steers under 20 months. NO BULLS
- Neck straps are to be used on all cattle stalled overnight on the Nabiac Showground.
- All cattle to be exhibited must have a Cattle Health Status Declaration Free Certificate forwarded with the entry form.
- Any matters not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Chief Steward.
- All Exhibitors must comply with NLIS requirements and must complete the attached Livestock Movement Form and return same to Mark Farley on arrival at the Show.

Exhibitors are requested to parade their cattle in the Grand Parade at 2.45 p.m. A gate prize of \$50 will be drawn from all Grand Parade exhibitors. Tickets will be handed out at entry to Ring

**Overnight camping** is available from 4pm on the day prior to the show in the designated area at advertised rate of \$10:00 per night. Payable to show society

<u>Veterinary costs:</u> In the case of any cattle requiring veterinary inspection/ treatment whilst at this event, the owner of the cattle agrees that all cost incurred are their responsibility.
