- On arrival all exhibitors must register with and pay entry fee to Entry Stewards in the Produce Pavilion.
- All exhibits to be delivered to Showground between **7.30 am and 11.00 am Friday, 7th March, 2025**
- Produce Pavilion doors close for Judging at **11.00** am Friday. No further entry will be accepted.




