CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO SHOWGROUND

Nabiac Showgrounds is a designated **glass free** area, so no glass drink containers are to be brought onto the Nabiac Showgrounds.

The Wallamba District A & H Assoc. Inc. reserves the right to search for any prohibited item including, but not limited to, weapons, controlled, dangerous or illegal substances, alcohol (bottles or cans) which are expressly forbidden and subject to confiscation.

No alcohol is to be carried or consumed in the sideshow area.

Alcohol must only be consumed in the designated licenced area.

Drunken, unruly offensive behaviour or fighting will result in immediate removal from the showground.

The speed limit for all vehicles within the showground area is 5 kilometres per hour which is walking speed.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

Any exhibitor intending to bring electrical equipment to the showground will be required to ensure all electric leads, tools, and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is a requirement of The Occupational Health and Safety act 1983.

Please check all equipment meets this criterion before being brought onto the showgrounds.

Please read carefully

- Competition is open to ALL CHILDREN **17 years and under. Please state your age & birthday on the Entry Form**

NOTE: The children's entries in Sections 20 to 24 will now be in three age groups i.e. 5yrs to 8yrs, 9yrs to 12yrs and 13yrs to 17yrs

Class 57 in Section 26 only is also part of the 3 age group classification

- The name of the exhibitor must **NOT** be shown on the front of the exhibit
- Baked goods to be displayed on plain white plate
- Fruit & vegetables to be displayed on/in a plain white container. Containers will **NOT** be provided by Show
- Eggs must be displayed in egg cartons with no embellishments
- All care will be taken of exhibits but the Committee takes no responsibility for damage to or theft of same
- On arrival all exhibitors must register with an Entry Steward

Children's **HALL** entries are made at a special table **IN the Hall**

Children's **PRODUCE** entries are made directly at the **Produce Shed**

- Children's exhibits may be delivered to the Showground between **3:00pm and 5:30pm on Thursday 5th March, 2026 or on Friday 6th March between 7:30am and 11:00am**
- Hall doors **close** for judging at **11:00 am** on Friday. No further entry will be accepted.
- **Judges' decisions will be final**
- Hall will re-open on Saturday, 7th March, 2026 at 8:00am & close at 7.30pm
- A ribbon will be awarded for the Most Successful Children's Exhibitor
- Prize money may be collected from Secretary's Office **after 12.00** noon on Show Day or between, **9:30am to 11:00am** on Sunday, 8th
- Any prize money not collected by Sunday will be deemed as a donation to the Show funds
- Exhibits may be collected between **9:00 & 11:00am** on Sunday 8th


